Tracks Not To Scale

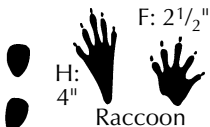
Tracks will show considerable variation depending upon conditions of ground (snow, mud, dust, sand, etc.) and movement of animal.

T: Tail marks may be present

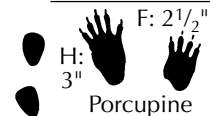

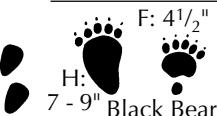
